- 2) Discussed a proposed change in zoning as recommended by the Zoning Hearing Board; specifically breweries, wineries, and distilleries are permitted only in Industrial Zones. It was recommended by George Guido, Chairman of the Zoning Hearing Board that Council researches expanding these types of businesses into being allowed in Commercial zones as well.
- 3) Discussed a draft ordinance for police so that the City is in accordance with Civil Service.
- 4) Discussed informational joint meeting between the Municipal Authority and Council to discuss the Long Term Control Plan. The meeting will be Tuesday, January 19, 2016 at 6:30 PM.
