GENERAL ITEMS OF DISCUSSION:

- 1) Announced Executive Session held on September 8, 2016 to discuss School Resource Officer from 6:15 to 7:25 PM.
- 2) Discussed a possible Household Hazardous Waste event in Lower Burrell. Rich Yank a loyal member of the Recycling Task Force explained the event which would include electronic recycling. It will be held November 12, 2016, two weeks after the bi-annual recycling event. Council asked questions regarding traffic and insurance. Motion by Councilman Fabry, second by Councilman Grillo to approve the collection of recyclable materials on November 12, 2016 from 9 am to 1 pm. - 3) Motion by Councilman Koziarski, second by Councilman Grillo to award bid for Fisher Hall Replacement of ADA Accessible Ramp to JT Construction, the lowest responsible bidder for \$50,000. Roll call vote indicated: Councilman Koziarski: AYE; Councilman Grillo: AYE; Councilman Trozzi: AYE; Councilman Fabry: AYE. 4 "AYES." All in favor.
- 4) Discussed request from New Kensington/PennDOT in regards to traffic study on Greensburg Road. This request was approved and a letter will be sent to PennDOT.
- 5) Motion by Councilman Fabry, second by Councilman Grillo to approve Agreement with Hoffman's Kennels. Roll call vote indicated: Councilman Fabry: AYE; Councilman Grillo: AYE; Councilman Koziarski: AYE; Councilman Trozzi: AYE. 4 "AYES." All in favor.
