Sewer Report

Performed sewer lateral inspections at 125 Logans Ferry Road and along with 2785, 2785R, 2791, 2801, 2820, and 2824 on Seventh Street Road. (Wildlife Lodge Sewer Line Extension Project.) Changed Pump #2 in Indiana Pump Station. Installed Pump #2 at Hillcrest Estates Pump Station. Replace Pump #1 at Widmer Pump Station. Utilized Vactor to clean out Indian Fields Pump Station. Performed camera evaluations during rain events: "Harvey area;" Allen, Iowa, Jefferson; Alder from Limba; Russell; Claremont; Montana right of way. Installed green manhole marker posts on Wildlife Lodge and Widmer Sewer right of ways. Cameraed roots on Ireland due to a sewer backup. Cameraed Edith from Montana to Idaho due to a reported sinkhole in the Water company's water line extension project area the prior day. Continued to perform vehicle maintenance. Utilized New Ken's excavator to raise two manholes, reset two cones, and terminated two of the old existing manholes

on the Route 56 right of way. We also removed sediment from the drainage ditch line on the sewer right of way below Wentworth. Performed PA One Calls as needed. Conducted manhole inspection reports from Allan to Iowa to Jefferson. Cut roots from Limba to Alder right of way, and cleaned out Iowa to Allen with the Vactor in order to evaluate with the camera. Assisted Arnold utilizing the Vactor for approximately 1-1/2 hours one day; 3.5 hours on another. Checked, cleaned/greased and checked all pump stations; performed end of month cleaning and cut grass when needed. Conducted monthly safety inspections of all pump stations. Bill Thomey attended "Certified Stormwater Inspector Training" on April 18 and 19, 2016, in Pittsburgh. Terry Anderson attended both the Public Works Safety and the City Hall Safety meetings.
