Sewer Report

Completed yard restoration for the Indiana Pump Station force Main project, Located lateral on Pgh St, and MH J04__016 that was buried along with the laterals for empty lot on Hillcrest Dr., Finished Carl Ave Stormline evaluation, Utilized Vactor to clean sanitary lines on Edna, and 3535 Riverview, also used Vactor and pressure washer to clean the asphalt pad, pavilions, and benches at Veteran's Central Park in preparation for the NHS/BHS Day of Caring event, Pressure washed the bocci court and utilized Vactor to clean the walking bridge at Kotecki Park, Located & raised buried MH D05__022 on Edna, Performed sewer inspections at 2615 Virginia, 110 Delberta, 452 Donnell Road, 310 Kurt Street, 3415 Windyhill Road, Utilized Vactor at New Ken Public Works to clean 3 inlets, Performed sewer line evaluations during rain events from Edgecliff to Rodgers Hillcrest Pump Station - Installed a new pump (#2), Little Braeburn - Put chemicals in to deter sewer smell Craigdell Pump Station – Cleaned sensors, Indiana Pump Station – Installed a fabricated check valve assembly and gasket from SDB Technologies, cleaned sensors, installed check valve, installed a new blower at dry well Widmer Pump Station – Installed a new sump pump, began to rebuild Chicago pumps, put pump in Widmer's Dry Well, Big Braeburn – Pulled pump #4 due to broken volute/motor bolts, had SDB make two new volute gaskets, will install when bolts come in from McMaster, Aided in the installation of a 15" storm pipe and grading up at ABC Fields, Shortened the Arizona storm pipe and installed rip rap at its outlet to reduce erosion Jet cleaned driveway pipe at 3420 Waugaman, Laing Rd pipe, and various inlets throughout the city due to storm events, Performed camera evaluation on Carl Storm line and Kurt Street, 120 Arizona Drive, Continued routine maintenance root cutting and line cleaning list, Marked PA One Calls as needed, Conducted monthly safety inspections of all Pump Stations

Engineer's Report

1. LITTLE PUCKETA INTERCEPTOR I/I REMOVAL PROJECT

Insituform submitted a request for substantial completion on May 21, 2019. This request was accompanied by a repair plan for all of the punchlist items identified by Mott MacDonald and Lower Burrell. A majority of the repairs will be completed by a new sub consultant BLD Inc. These repairs include robotic cutting/grind of liner defects and the installation of a point repair liners as well as additional lateral connection repair liners. Shop drawings for all repair products were submitted and are pending the submission of supporting calculations. Rehabilitation crew is currently scheduled for July 8th-July 15th.

2. LITTLE PUCKETA SEWER REHABILITATION PROJECT

Mott MacDonald has proceeded with preparing the plan and profile drawings of the existing system. The project has been reviewed for the potential to utilize pipe bursting to avoid excavation around existing utilities. Mott MacDonald intends to bid the project with an alternative bid pricing for this option. Mott MacDonald has proceeded to develop specs and drawings for this project. A project review meeting was held with LBMA on May 31, 2019.

Mott MacDonald arranged with Lower Burrell to have a PA One call completed for these project areas. Once utilities are marked Mott MacDonald will record locations and add the locations to the drawing set and prepare the advertisement for bid.

3. CHARTIERS PUMP STATION UPGRADE PROJECT

The flow monitoring phase of this project began on February 1, 2019. A total of 28 flow meters were installed

throughout the Rodgers Hollow, Widmer Pump Station, and Alder Hollow drainages to quantify the impact of the Little Pucketa I/I Removal Project. Flow meters remained in place for 3 months and were removed during the first week of May 2019. Payment for the final two months of flow monitoring are included in the June Invoicing. Geotechnical work is currently scheduled for the week of June 17, 2019. Eichelberger's Inc will be conducting the drilling while Mott MacDonald will oversee the boring and testing as well as prepare the geotechnical report. The Syiek's were notified on Monday June 10, 2019 of the timeframe of the work to be performed.

Geotechnical work is currently underway

Also discussed getting a bridge loan to finance the force main replacement until we can get a PENNVEST loan. May have to wait for the pump station project due to pipe tie in issues.
