E-scrap recycling will soon be mandatory in Pennsylvania

Items that **MUST BE RECYCLED**:

Mandated Devices as defined by CDRA (All televisions, and anything directly connected to a computer system):

- ◇ CPUs/Towers
- ◇ Laptops
- ◇ Computer monitors—CRT and LED/LCD
- ◇ Peripherals (mice, keyboards, speakers)
- ◇ Printers
- ◇ Copiers (desktop and stand-alone)
- ◇ TVs—all types and sizes (console, desktop, rear projection, etc.)

Items not mandated but **SHOULD BE RECYCLED**:

Non-mandated Electronic Devices:

- ◇ Answering Machines Telephone systems
- ◇ Camcorders Cell phones
- ◇ Cameras Docking Stations
- ◇ Electric typewriters Pagers
- ◇ Radios Remote Controls
- ◇ VCR/DVD players Microwaves
- ◇ Medical equipment Testing equipment
- ◇ Rechargeable batteries
- ◇ Stereos/tape/CD players
- ◇ Toner/ink cartridges
- ◇ Fax/copy machines/duplicators
- ◇ Gaming consoles/controllers

The **PA Covered Devices Recycling Act of 2010 (CDRA)** dictates that all electronic devices defined in the act be banned from landfill disposal and must be recycled. Consumers and small businesses (those with fewer than 50 employees) must have access to electronic scrap recycling programs at no cost to them. A **FREE** e-scrap recycling drop-off program is available to meet your needs.

Who can use the service: Any consumer or small business

Which Small Businesses can participate: Any business with fewer than 50 employees.

Larger retailers and businesses with more than 50 employees must contract with qualified e-scrap vendors to meet their recycling needs.
