## ACCEPTABLE Items for Recycling

Motor Oil	Automatic Transmission Fluid
Hydraulic/Chainsaw Oil	Brake Fluid
Kerosene	Rear End Grease (Liquid)
Hot water tanks	Dryers
Stoves	Washers
Lawn mowers <i>(must be drained of ALL gasoline/oil)</i>	
Batteries: Car/ Lead Acid Type (No lithium or nickel cadmium)	
Scrap Metal: We take only bare metal	

## Freon Items (R.W. Recycling)

\$15 / 25 – Refrigerator (SM/LG)  
\$15– Window Air Conditioner/Humidifiers  
\$10– Microwaves

## Used Tires (Tire Stop)

\$ 3.00 – Any tire; On/Off Rim  
(Large Truck/Tractor size NOT accepted)  
\$ 5.00 – Tires with caked mud

**Latex Paints ONLY (NO Oil based paint):** \$2/per gallon or smaller can. \$4/per larger can.

Burrell School District is **NO** longer able to collect empty inkjet & laser cartridges (visit Staples to recycle)

We **CANNOT** take the following items or HHW (see below for hazardous material collection information)
