ACCEPTABLE Items for Recycling

Motor Oil
Hydraulic/Chainsaw Oil
Kerosene
Hot water tanks
Stoves
Lawn mowers (*must be drained of ALL gasoline/oil*)
Batteries: Car / Motorcycle / Truck
Scrap Metal: We take only bare metal

Automatic Transmission Fluid
Brake Fluid
Rear End Grease (Liquid)
Dryers
Washers

Freon Items (R.W. Recycling)

\$15 / 25 – Refrigerator (SM/LG)
\$15 – Window Air Conditioner/Humidifiers
\$5 – Microwaves

Used Tires (Tire Stop)

\$ 2.00 – Any tire; On/Off Rim
(Large Truck/Tractor size NOT accepted)

Latex Paints ONLY (NO Oil based paint): \$2/per gallon or smaller can. \$4/per larger can.

Burrell School District is collecting empty inkjet & laser cartridges to help obtain free technical supplies. We will collect them at this Recycling Day event, or please drop them off at any of the school district offices.

We **CANNOT** take the following items or HHW (see below for hazardous material collection information)

Gasoline NO Drums of Any Fluid Carburetor Cleaners 2-cycle oil Cleaning Solvents Acetone
Oil Based Paint Antifreeze Machine/Cutting Fluids Stone Wood Plastic Pesticides Sealants

There is NO Electronic Recycling during this event.

NOTE II: Residential curbside recycling NOW includes phone books, magazines, paperboard (cereal boxes), & ALL plastics (1-7)!! Please place items in blue bins on your recycling day (No cardboard).
