The following items will be collected from any Lower Burrell resident.

ACCEPTABLE Items for Recycling

Motor Oil	Automatic Transmission Fluid
Hydraulic/Chainsaw Oil	Brake Fluid
Kerosene	Rear End Grease (Liquid)
Hot water tanks	Dryers
Stoves	Washers
Lawn mowers <i>(must be drained of ALL gasoline/oil)</i>	
Batteries: Car / Motorcycle / Truck	
Scrap Metal: We take only bare metal	

Freon Items (R.W. Recycling)

\$15 / 25 – Refrigerator (SM/LG)
\$15 – Window Air Conditioner/Humidifiers
\$5 – Microwaves

Used Tires (Tire Stop)

1 Tire = \$2, >1 Tire = \$1.50/each
Rounded to nearest whole dollar
(i.e. 2=\$3, 3=\$5, 4=\$6, 5=\$8, etc.)

Latex Paints ONLY (NO Oil based paint): \$2/per gallon or smaller can. \$4/per larger can.

Burrell School District is collecting empty inkjet & laser cartridges to help obtain free technical supplies. We will collect them at this Recycling Day event, or please drop them off at any of the school district offices.

We CANNOT take the following items or HHW (see below for hazardous material collection information)

Gasoline NO Drums of Any Fluid Carburetor Cleaners 2-cycle oil Cleaning Solvents Acetone
Oil Based Paint Antifreeze Machine/Cutting Fluids Stone Wood Plastic Pesticides Sealants



There is NO Electronic Recycling during this event.

NOTE I: Paper only recycling available again at Lower Burrell city hall! These are paper only recycling bins for magazines, junk mail, office paper, & newspapers (No cardboard, phone books, or pizza boxes).

NOTE II: Residential curbside recycling NOW includes phone books, magazines, paperboard (cereal boxes), & ALL plastics (1-7)!! Please place items in blue bins on your recycling day (No cardboard).

The city is hoping in 2017 to hold an electronics and household chemical collection event. HHW items include antifreeze, paint products (oil, sealants), pesticides, etc. See city web site for updates in the spring.
